Terms and conditions ENGLISH SUMMER S.A. 2016

1. Prospectus.

Along with the prospectus these terms and conditions are for the current year and are given to the participant to outline the terms and conditions for the participant and English Summer SA. The prospectus includes information about Language courses, duration of course, calendar, accommodation characteristics, activities, prices and necessary information about the different programs. The information included in the prospectus is binding for English Summer SA except in the following circumstances:

- Changes in the previously stated information will be communicated in writing to the participant or legal representative before the start date of the contract, and that this possibility has been stated previously.
- Following any subsequent amendments, expressly agreed in writing between the contracting parties.
- There is a case of force majeure.

2. Legal regulation applicable to the contract and acceptance of the Terms and Conditions.

The General Conditions are subject to terms and conditions resulting from the application of RDL 1/2007 of 16th November, which approves the revised text of the General Law in the Defense of Consumers and Users, Law 7/1998 of 13th April of the General Terms and Conditions of the contract, law 34/2002 of July 11th, Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce, and the Civil Code. The present Terms and Conditions are incorporated and signed by all contracting parties, applicable to all English Summer SA contracts, the object of which are the programs contained in the prospectus, obliging all parties, along with extra conditions agreed in the contract that can be established for each program.

3. Services which are included.

In each of the programs the center is specified, duration, timing, course characteristics and activities as well as price, and indicates the inclusion of different component services. These are:

- Accommodation on a full board basis, except for external students which only includes maintenance during the day.
- English classes according to schedule and timetable, their tuition and assistance from teachers. In the case of the technological program the classes will be applied technology.
- Necessary teaching material for each program.
- Supervision and mentoring by instructors.
- Activities as directed in the schedule.
- Handcraft materials (except program for students older than 13years old).
- Personal report (academic, living, health, etc.).
- Certificate of attendance.
- 2 T-Shirts and a folder for each participant.
- Trophies and diplomas depending on results.
- Laundry services as per the schedule (except external students).
- Accident insurance and liability.
- IVA (tax) is included in all prices.
- English Summer S.A. charges 100 euros in administrative fees. This quantity is included in the price.

Services which are not included:

- Personal expenses incurred during stay.
- Excursions and activities indicated as optional.
- Transport services from other towns, airports, ports or train/bus stations, which will be billed apart.
- Medical insurance and costs of medical treatment.

4. Inscription conditions.

Filling out the inscription form for the courses offered by English Summer SA either personally, online, or through a third person (delegate, agency, family member, friend, etc), does not imply prior acceptance of enrollment to the course. Inscriptions are preregistration and pending to confirmation of enrollment. For the student to be definitively registered the following three requirements must be reached:

(1) The inscription form and the terms and conditions must be filled out and signed, (2) the reservation fee must have been paid, and (3) have received a written copy of the letter of acceptance from English Summer SA confirming the reservation. Inscriptions are personal and not transferable. If you have made a pre-inscription, the registration will be kept in a waiting list pending formal finalization. The formalization period for veteran students ends on the 27th January. From this date there will be no preference for preinscriptions. Each of the courses offered by English Summer SA have a limited number of spaces. If no spaces are available in the required course an alternative course will be offered for alternative

dates or the same dates in a different centre depending upon availability. In the case that this is not possible will remain on the waiting list for the required course. The registration fee of the course is considered to be independent of the chosen form of payment.

However, this may be annulled if before starting the course the full price agreed in the letter of acceptance of registration has not been paid. In the prospectus the registration fee is indicated for each course. This amount will be discounted from the total cost of the course. Payment of the reservation fee is considered as payment made on account of the initial reservation costs. Payment details can be found in the prospectus.

5. Cancellation, No Show and/or abandonment of the program by the participant.

In the event that a participant or his legal representative decides to cancel the contracted program, this must be communicated in writing to English Summer SA. The participant is entitled to a refund of amounts paid to English Summer SA. However, the participant must pay English Summer SA the expenses incurred in the administrative fees, except in the event that the cancellation is made by force majeure.

Cancellation of the courses will incur the following costs where appropriate, they amount to:

15% of the final price of the course if the cancellation occurs between 30 and 15 days from the Stara date of the program, 25% of the final price of the course if the cancellation occurs between 14 and 6 days from the start date of the course, and 100% of the final price of the course if the cancellation occurs 5 days before the start date of the course. A no show of the course participant at the start of the contracted course will entail the total loss of all payments made for the course. The administrative fees of 100 euros must be paid to English Summer SA in all cases and, similarly, will not be refunded in any case, unless cancellation insurance has been contracted. The participant is not entitled to any refund if, after starting the program, leaves willingly by decision of their parents or their legal representatives, or by reason of dismissal (expulsion from the course).

The cost of the plane ticket or any other transport costs that English Summer contracts for its clients through Travel Agencies, are not included as part of the program with regards to cancellation as conditions are different depending on each company contracted, airline etc. In this case the cancellation fees will be considered on an individual basis. The sum of services included in the price of the course is considered as a complete package and not divisible, and since they are offered to all participants, may not be deducted separately, even though one participant decides not to participate in any activity or voluntarily chooses not to take part in the course.

6. Program Changes and incidents.

English Summer SA agrees to provide all participants of the contracted services included in the program, with the conditions and stipulated characteristics. However the following details should be taken into account:

a) In the event that, prior to the start of the program, English Summer SA is forced to change significantly an essential element of the contract, including, price, shall immediately inform the participant. The participant may elect to terminate the contract without being charged, or accept the change in the contract. In the latter case, English Summer SA will specify the amendments, and its impact on the price of the program.

b) The participant must communicate their decision as soon as possible, and in all cases, within three days of being notified of the changes in the program. If the student does not inform English Summer SA of their decision within three days it will be understood that the student opts for the change to the program without extra charge.

c) In the event that English Summer SA is forced to cancel any of its programs for reasons not attributable to the participant, or in the event that the participant elects to terminate the contract under the provisions of paragraphs a) or b) English Summer SA offers the participant an alternative program of equal or higher quality, or return to the participant all the amounts paid for the program. In this case, English Summer SA shall also indemnify the participant for breach of contract the following amounts: 15% of the program if the cancellation occurs between 30 and 15 days of the date of start of the program, 25% of the program if cancellation occurs between 14 and 6 days of the start of the program, and 100% of the program if cancellation is made within 5 days prior to program start date.

d) There shall be no obligation on the part of English Summer SA to compensate the participant when the cancellation of the program is due to reasons of force majeure.

e) Neither will there be an obligation on the part of English Summer SA to compensate the participant in the event that cancellation of the program occurs due to not achieving the minimum number of 15 participants required for the effective realization of the course. In this case English Summer S.A. will give written notice to the participant at least fifteen days prior to the date of the start of the program that has not reached the minimum number of participants and, therefore, the program that has been canceled. In the event of cancellation of the program due to not reaching the minimum number of participants shall be entitled to reimbursement of all ~~Admission and the program cost of the program.~~

The start of the course is established once finalized the admission at the centre, where family members of legal representative hands in the necessary documentation, in this moment English Summer SA takes charge of the student. In the case of students arriving by transfer, it will be from the moment that accredited personnel collect the student. English Summer SA reserves the right not to admit students that are not in possession of the necessary documentation. This includes: the personal medical form, health card, authorization from legal guardian and receipt of payment for the course. The inaccuracy, concealment or lack of data and student's personal circumstances may be grounds for cancellation of registration by English Summer SA. In case of contagious disease, English Summer SA reserves the right not to admit the student on to the course. In the event that the full payment of the course has not been made in the indicated period, it will be understood that the participant has rejected the course.

In the event that an optional transfer has been contracted to or from the airport, train/bus station or town, it should be notified with sufficient time, handing in the necessary documentation. These are:

Travel tickets, identity documents, travel authorization, etc. English Summer SA will not be responsible for any charges incurred due to missing documents (cancellations, cost of buying new tickets and other administrative duties). In the case of transfers, as in other optional trips, English Summer SA only acts as a mediator with other transport companies and services and therefore cannot be held responsible for possible delays, cancellations, changes, accidents or loss of luggage.

8. Binding rules in the program development.

The participant agrees to respect the rules regarding hours, compulsory attendance, behavior and contact with teachers and peers, as well as compliance with general rules, bans consumption of tobacco, alcohol and drugs, etc. English Summer SA gives the participant a copy of the rules in the different centers.

9. Possible Expulsions.

In the event that a participant in the course does not abide by the rules of the center due to discipline, underage alcohol consumption, consumption of drugs etc, the participant could be expelled from the program. In this case, the participant or legal representative will be responsible for the costs relating to their travel home: cancellation costs, fair home, indemnity for damages and any costs that English Summer SA suffers or incurs caused by the students acts, apart from any further liability.

10. Claims.

Differences and / or claims at the judgment of participants arising during contracted program should be made known to English Summer SA, in order to provide a satisfactory solution with an immediate effect. In the event that the proposed solution is not satisfactory to the participant or his legal representative, they have a period of 30 calendar days to file a written claim with English Summer SA. In turn, English Summer SA after having received the relevant documentation, shall have a period of 30 calendar days to respond to the complaint of the participant. The 30 calendar days will commence the day following the filing of the complaint with English Summer SA

11. Insurance.

In compliance with current legislation, English Summer SA has signed liability policies and accident insurance with AXA. A copy of the policies are available to any interested party. English Summer SA is not responsible for lost or misplaced items of the participant that have not been taken into care specifically by the unless justified.

12. Technical organization of travel.

In the event that the administration of travel tickets is contracted by English Summer SA, the technical organisation is done through a travel agency with an authorization code. English Summer SA. acts as the intermediary between the participant and the travel agency. For this reason English Summer SA is not responsible for cancellations, timetable changes, route changes, delays, accidents, loss of luggage etc. The participant authorizes English Summer SA to buy tickets directly from an airline, the import of which will be paid to English Summer SA by the client.

13. Using the image of the participants.

In accordance with the rights of image regulated by law 5/1982 of 5 May, English Summer SA reserves the right to use all graphic material, photographs, or other apparatus that the participants image appears during the course with regards to the activities related to the course, published on the web, or in publications by English Summer SA. Or for publication and advertising courses, always when there is no previously expressed opposition by the participant. In any case, the authorization can be revoked at any time by the participant but the participant must pay indemnity to English Summer SA for costs or damages caused.

14. Legal authorization for minors.

At the moment of admission and start of the program the personal medical form must be handed to English Summer SA along with necessary medical and legal authorizations signed by a legal representative of the minor. These are, authorization to take part in all the activities, programmed sports and extra activities that could be included and to participate in activities that occur outside the school premises. In the case of optional trips / excursions, trips outside the school premises or emergency journeys, authorizing the corresponding journey. In the event that the transfer service has been contracted to or from the airport, train or bus stations or towns further documentation will also be requested: Authorization that the participant can travel by plane, train or boat, be the minimum amount of time possible in the arrivals terminal before being collected by family members. Authorization for the journey to or from the school. In the case of indemnity costs that exceed the policy contracted by English Summer SA (Cover goes up to 151,000 euros) will be the responsibility of the participant or legal guardian.

15. Medical and / or surgical treatment of the participant.

In the event that a participant who is a minor is in a situation needing medical treatment, and/or needs to be hospitalized, and/or needs surgical intervention and English Summer SA has not been able to locate parents or legal guardians English Summer will be authorized to make any decision necessary to safeguard the health of the participant as medically prescribed. Expenditure of care, medication and transportation not covered by Social Security or the participants private insurance will be charged to the participants account.

16. Data protection.

In compliance with the provisions of Law 15/1999 of December 13th, regarding the protection of Personal data, English Summer SA informs you that personal data provided in the registration of the participant, as well as academic information, tutorials and accounting, will be incorporated into an automated file belonging English Summer SA with responsibility for maintenance and use for purposes related to the activity of English Summer SA. The acceptance of these general conditions implies consent to carry out such use, and for use with the mentioned purposes. The client is also advised of the possibility of exercising rights regarding access, rectification, opposition and cancellation in the terms established in the legislation, at: English Summer SA C/ St.Francesc, 4.43003 Tarragona.

17. Effectiveness.

The validity of these general conditions of the Prospectus is the current year. The validity of this Prospectus is from January 1st 2016 to December 31st, 2016. The release date of the terms is December 2th, 2015.

18. Conflict resolution.

Any dispute arising between parties concerning the interpretation, compliance and performance of this contract will be resolved by the courts with jurisdiction under applicable law.

19. Individual conditions for the programs.

Are established by all parties on an individual basis.

20. Prescription of actions.

Actions arising from this contract will prescribe after two years.
