

Check-list

¿WHAT TO BRING?



Don't forget anything! An unforgettable adventure begins soon. Pack your suitcase with everything you'll need. Use the following list to make sure your packing is properly organized.

Necessary documentation

- I have submitted the form with the medical information.
- Health card (original, no photocopies).
- Private insurance card (if you have one).
- Vaccination record.
- ID or passport for the transfer service.

For students from Andorra and other countries:

- Social Security or private insurance travel agreement.
- Photocopy Passport .

Personal clothing (marked with name)

- Sneakers.
- Activewear for physical activity.
- T-shirts and shorts.
- Underwear and two pajamas. Socks: for sports and dressy wear.
- A sweater/sweatshirt (extra if going to Prades).
- Long pants or jeans.
- Elegant clothes for the gala party.

Swimwear

- 2 towels for the pool. One for the shower and one for face and hands.
- At least two swimsuits and shower/beach slippers.
- Closed flip-flops (for the beach).

Stationary

- Case with personal materials: colors, school scissors, etc.

Toiletry bag

- Soap, shampoo, and sponge.
- Anti-parasite lotion (as a preventative measure*).
- Toothbrush and toothpaste, cologne, and comb.
- Protective creams for skin and lips.
- Mosquito repellent cologne (not insecticidal).



Important items

- 4 special mesh bags for washing machines (except for one-week camps).
- If glasses are worn, a spare pair.
- Flashlight with batteries (for night games).
- Optional: cell phone.
- Medications: These must be handed in to the instructor on the first day, indicating the student's full name, treatment, and dosage.

Check-list camp-list themed camps

- Water sports: swimwear, closed-toe flip-flops, a hat, sunscreen, etc.
- Horse riding: boots and appropriate clothing.
- Dancing: comfortable dance attire.

For the rest of the camps, you don't need to bring anything; the center will provide all the necessary materials.

What we will provide

- Camp T-shirt and your team's sports shirt.
- Class binder.
- Olympiad participation medal.
- Folder with documentation and a complete report.

Things you cannot bring

- Valuables and electronic devices (except cell phones).
- Lighters, firecrackers, tobacco, alcohol, etc.

We recommend adding a packing list to your suitcase to ensure nothing is missing at the end of your stay.

*Head lice can affect people of any age, but school-aged children are most at risk. Therefore, we recommend that you receive treatment promptly before school begins.
